



Fundraising Contest

Who: Any student grades K-12 in Genesee County

What: The Humane Society of Genesee County's 2nd annual "Kids for Fur Kids" fundraising contest. Students plan and carry out their own fundraiser to benefit the many animals that come through the Humane Society's doors each year. They will make a tri-fold display board detailing their fundraiser and present money raised to the Humane Society.

When: Saturday, December 9th at 12 noon.

Where: The Humane Society of Genesee County, 3325 S. Dort Hwy., in Burton.

Why: To promote community involvement among students and to emphasize the importance of being kind to animals.

Contest Rules

1. **Students must submit the attached form to the Humane Society by November 1st, 2006 to participate.** Forms can be mailed, faxed or emailed. (information below)
2. Students plan and carry out their own fundraiser to benefit the many animals that come through the Humane Society's doors each year. **Students can organize their fundraiser individually or with a group.** All names involved in each fundraiser should be listed on the participation form, along with an adult that will be responsible for keeping students safe during their fundraising event. Students can make and sell items, put on a show and sell tickets, collect donations, (please no door to door without an adult) or any other creative way to host a fundraiser.
3. Students will make a tri-fold display board detailing their fundraiser and present money raised to the Humane Society. Please include how funds were raised, amount of time spent and the amount of funds raised. Pictures and graphs are encouraged. Be creative. Finished displays including an optional border must not exceed 36" by 48". The Humane Society does not furnish the display board for the contest.
4. The student must print his/her name, grade, teacher's name, and school on the enclosed entry form and attach it to the front, lower, right hand corner of their display. Please make additional copies of the entry form if necessary.
5. The finished tri-fold displays must be at the Humane Society, 3325 S. Dort Hwy., in Burton by Friday December 8th by 6:00 p.m. If a student cannot attend the contest on Saturday, December 9th 2006, at noon, to present the money raised from their fundraiser, they must present it beforehand to be eligible for the contest.

The tri-fold displays exhibiting the fundraising efforts of the student will be judged by a committee and awards will be presented to the top winner in each category, "Most Creative", "Most Funds Raised" and "Most dedication". Every student participating will receive a prize for helping the homeless pets in Genesee County.
